
Q3 Primary Sport Played



Q4 How were you recruited to UL Lafayette?





Q5 If you were recruited today, would you choose UL Lafayette?





Q6 What type of athletic aid did you receive this past year?






Q8 How would you categorize yourself?




Q10 Did your athletics participation prevent you from majoring in your curriculum of choice?


Q11 What is your overall current GPA?


Q20 Are you aware of the Athletic Department's grievance policy?


Q25 Overall, during your time at UL Lafayette, how would you rate your coaching staff as being concerned about your well-being? (Please elaborate as we value your opinion)






