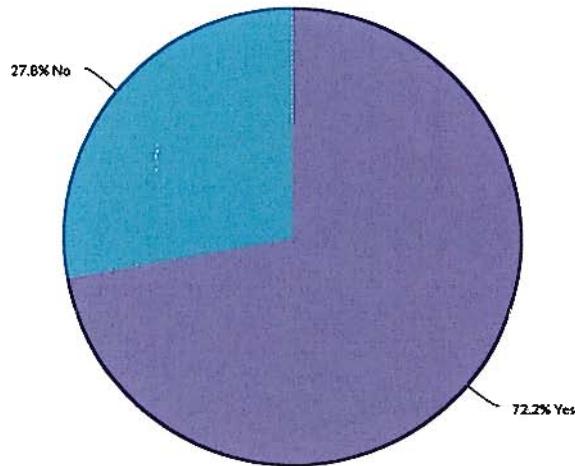

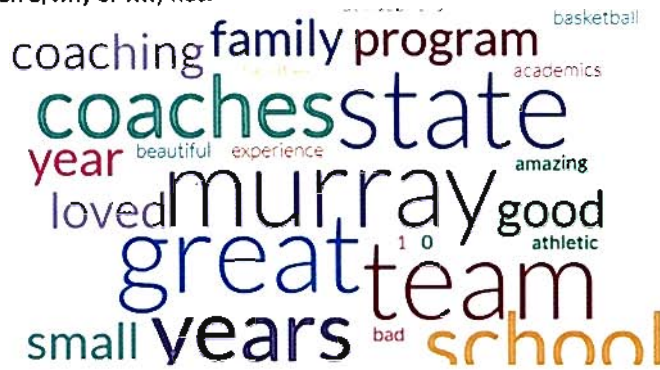

- I loved it at Murray state

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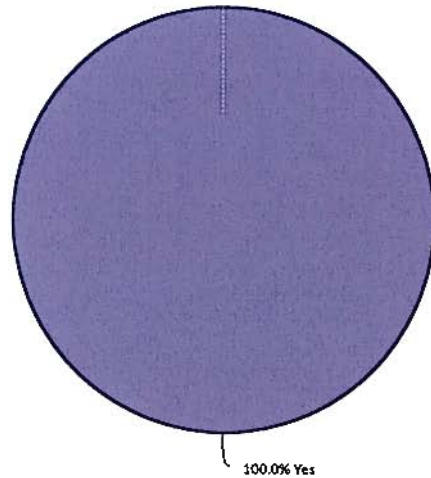

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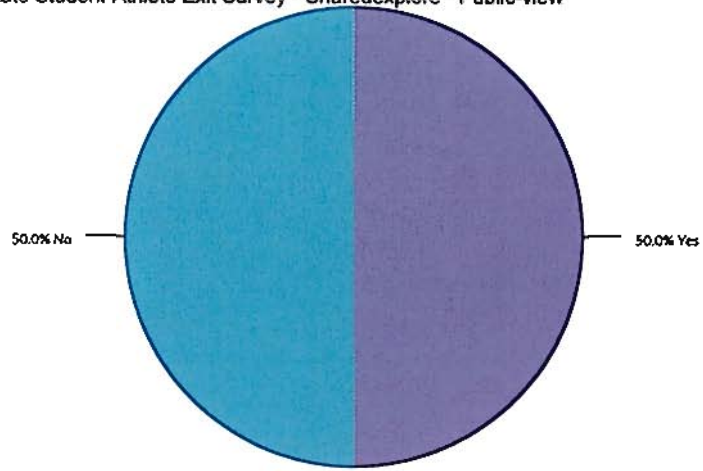
16. In your opinion, how is your sport's program trending at Murray State:

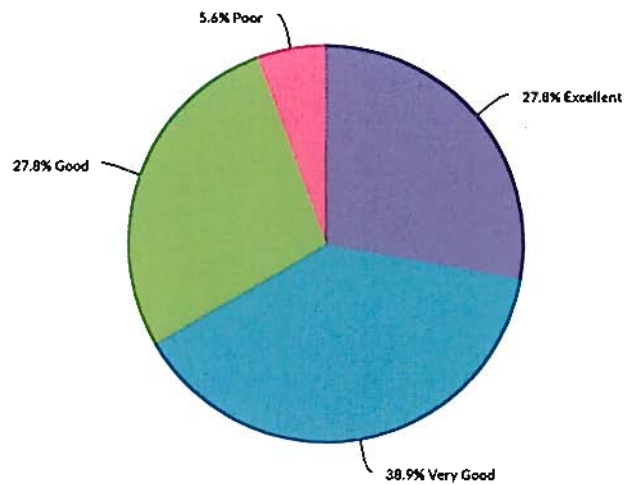
17. if you responded "Staying the same" to Question 16, do you consider your sport to be at a championship level?

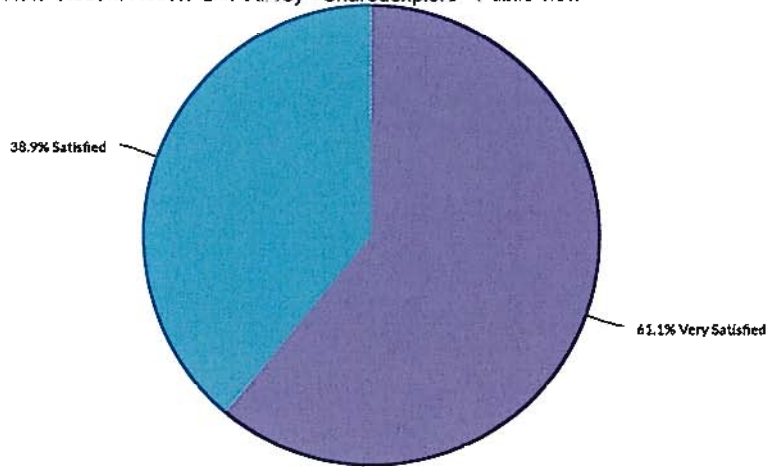
18. Using the scale below, rate the MSU Student-Athlete Services on how they met your academic assistance needs:

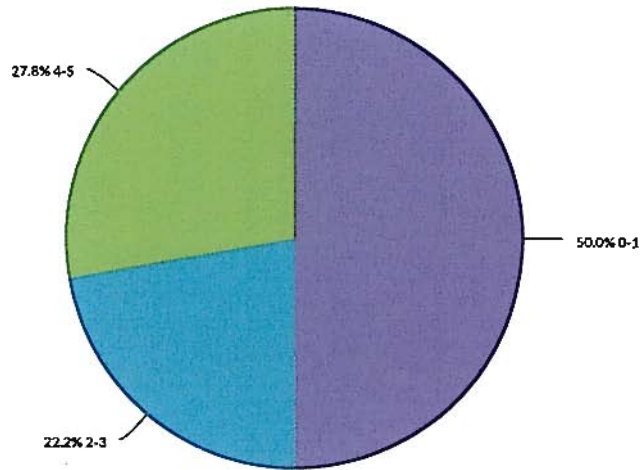
19. Using the scale below, rate your experience with the Weaver Academic Center:

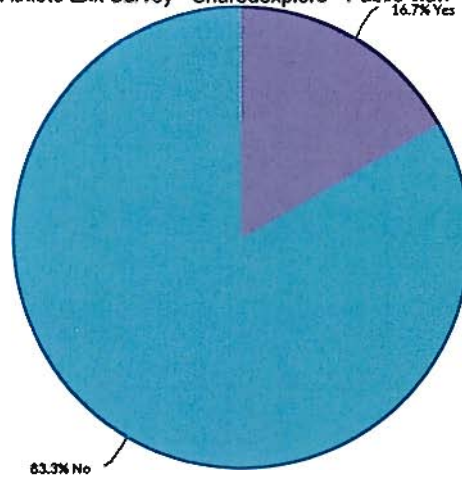
20. How many times per week did you use the Weaver Center to study or complete class assignments?

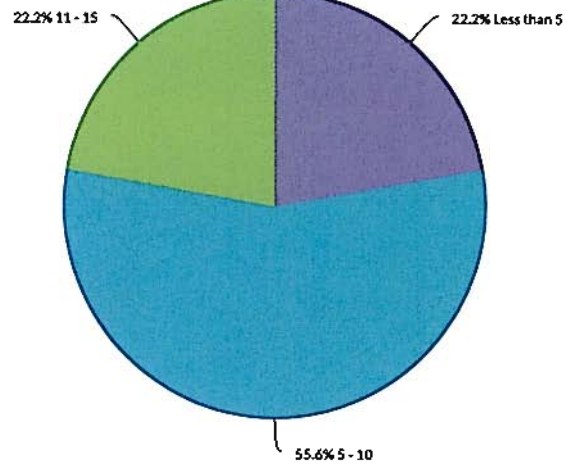
