Although the institution's coach does not intend to recruit while serving in their role as the alumni team's coach, it is important to note the coach may not use their status with the alumni team to circumvent the application of the personnel and recruiting rules outlined in the 6/6/01, Official Interpretation and the 11/11/15, Staff Interpretation.
