Interpretation:: No, the institution may not permissibly travel home on August 26, 2019 . Specifically, Bylaw 17.29.1.2.2 prohibits a foreign tour in basketball for a period which begins 30 days prior to the first permissible practice date until the first permissible date of competition in the championship segment.

In this case, the foreign tour prohibition period begins August 25, 2019 and would encompass the last two scheduled days of the referenced basketball foreign tour (August 19 - 26, 2019).
