Interpretation:: 12.8.1.7.1(a) requires that the SA meet the initial-full time collegiate enrollment prong (did not use a season of intercollegiate competition in his or her initial year of full-time, collegiate enrollment due to an institutional decision to redshirt the student-athlete; the student-athlete was listed on the institution's squad list and was eligible for competition during the segment of the season that concludes with the NCAA championship) plus one lost additional subsequent opportunity outside his control (the student-athlete was deprived of the opportunity to participate in intercollegiate competition in one other season due to circumstances beyond the control of the student-athlete or institution). Other lost opportunities within the SA and institution's control shouldn't factor into the analysis if both prongs are met.

Transfer Football SA who was redshirt his freshman year, coaches decision and was injured early August of his second year and had surgery and missed the entire season. Third year her did not play, coaches decision. 4th year transferred and played and has one year remaining on his 5 year clock. Because by law 12.8.1.7.1 (A) allows SA to get a freshman year back after missing a year beyond his control (Season ending injury) even though his missed a third year for coach decision. Does he qualify for the sixth year or could have only missed the first two years to meet the waiver criteria.
