Interpretation:: Since the SA is a four-year transfer in the sport of [REDACTED] (and therefore excluded from access to the one-time transfer exception), [REDACTED] academic eligibility at the previous institution solely impacts [REDACTED] ability to receive an athletics scholarship during [REDACTED] first year at the certifying institution (per Bylaw 14.5.5.4). To access an otherwise available scholarship, a progress-toward-degree waiver would be required.

The LRW transfer waiver would additionally be required to attempt to be immediately eligible for competition at the certifying institution.
