Instead, they are participating on club teams in many European countries. The institution's men's basketball coaching staff would like to evaluate and contact international recruits in their home countries, at club practices and competitions during the month of March. Is it permissible to recruit at these events during the March recruiting period?

Describe the interpretive request

Certifying institution has knowledge that the prospective student-athlete (PSA) transferred from a two-year institution and enrolled full-time at a four-year NAIA institution. However, the four-year institution doesn't indicate on his transcripts that he was enrolled since he wasn't enrolled on the census date that is how they determine enrollment. Non qualifier attended Cisco JUCO 4 full-time semesters: Fall 2016, Spring 2017, fall 2017, spring 2018 Informed the coaches that he was enrolled full-time fall 2018 at four-year institution on the first day and attended a couple classes, however he withdrew. Enrolled part-time at another 2-year institution Spring 2019 The transcript the certifying institution has from the four-year institution does not show any courses for the fall 2018. Certifying institution called the registrar's office at the four-year institution and they indicated that since he was not enrolled until their census date, the courses would not show up on the transcript. In order to to confirm full-time enrollment at the four-year institution the certifying institution would need to send a request to the registrar's office for an official letter confirming that he was enrolled on the first day since it is not indicated on PSA's transcript. Certifying institution would not have knowledge that PSA enrolled at four-year institution without the PSA indicating as such since his transcript doesn't show any classes. Does PSA have to be enrolled on the census date of the four-year institution to be considered to have been enrolled full-time or did he trigger 2-4 transfer status once he attended a class? We are needing to determine if PSA is now considered a 4-4 transfer to the certifying institution and determine progress towards degree status, or if certifying institution treats PSA as 2-4 transfer.

Provide the conference analysis of the interpretive request. That we would have to count the fall 2018 semester as full-time enrollment, therefore treating PSA as a 4-4 and including that semester in determining progress towards degree.

Certifying institution believes that since the PSA indicated to us that he enrolled full-time at a four-year institution and attended classes on the first day that we would include that semester in making our eligibility determinations; even though his four-year transcript doesn't include those classes.
