Rationale

Interpretation:: A student-athlete (SA) who has already transferred to one four-year institution as a graduate transfer (via Bylaw 14.6.1), would need waiver relief to be eligible at a subsequent graduate institution. The SA could potentially utilize the previously approved waiver criteria for graduate transfer, as outlined in the April 6, 2018 Educational Column, or in the event those criteria are not met, file a legislative relief four-year transfer waiver via RSRO.

The previously approved criteria that specifies "student-athlete graduated from the previous institution with eligibility remaining" does not require the student-athlete's to graduate from the intermediary graduate institution, but simply that he/she graduates from their undergraduate institution with remaining eligibility.
