Interpretation:: If your institution uses the cost-of-attendance definition of a full grant-in-aid, then the required course supplies to could be paid for as an element of financial aid as part of the cost-of-attendance gap. If your institution uses the old definition of a full grant-in-aid, including tuition, fees, room, board and books, then the additional required course supplies could be paid for pursuant to Bylaw 16.3.1.1, but would not be paid for as financial aid. Based on the facts provided, it is impermissible for batteries to be included as part of a book scholarship purchase.
