

'19-'20 Men's Tennis Rules/Agreements

Academics:

- Go to class, tutors, study hall, and academic meetings
- No cheating on homework, projects, or exams - this is cause for expulsion
- Below a 3.0 GPA will be subject to study hall
- No schedule changes without speaking with the academic coordinator and myself
- Be appreciative, respectful, and professional with Academics' time and resources

Practice/Competition:

- Be on time for practices, conditioning workouts, meetings, matches, and team activities
- Be organized with the training room and your treatments
- Absolutely no code violating behavior on the court, including no racket/ball abuse; swearing
- No cell phones during practice/match, meetings, or meals; cell phones turned off until dismissed
- Comply with practice/match/travel wardrobe guidelines
- No fighting allowed
- You are expected to try your best in every match, practice, and workout
- No intramural participation without the consent of the coaching staff
- Be proactive about squeegeeing needs

Ethics:

- Absolutely no smoking (including vaping), illegal drug use, or illegal use of alcohol
 - o No drinking 48 hours prior to a competition for those of legal drinking age
- Absolutely no involvement in any form of illegal activity
- You are expected to represent the team and the athletic dept with honor, pride, and respect
- Have the utmost care for the facility and locker room
- Facebook and Twitter accounts must comply with FGCU standards; you are not a normal student
- You are required to participate in community outreach and fundraising activities
- Call every head coach 'Coach'
- No surprise rule - if you do something wrong, admit it and immediately rectify it
- Take care of mindless tasks immediately
- Only English is to be spoken when any person is around who cannot understand your language

Disciplinary issues will be handled on a case by case scenario, but could result in immediate loss of athletics aid and/or dismissal from the team if behavior is deemed destructive by the coaching staff and administration.

I understand that student-athletes are expected to comply with the Student Code of Conduct as outlined in the University's Student Guidebook, policies established by the Department of Athletics as outlined in the Student-Athlete Handbook, and their respective team rules established by the head coach. Student-athletes have a special responsibility to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects well upon the University, the Department of Athletics, and themselves.
